General information about Slovenia

Homelessness

Provision is focused around Centres for the Homeless. These provide shelter and basic services and are run mainly by voluntary sector organisations. Supported accommodation is also available, especially for people with mental health problems. Ljubljana has a number of other services for the homeless, including centres for drug users and soup runs.

Welfare benefits

Individual benefits do not exist. When a person returns to their family the head of household makes an application to Social services on the basis of additional household costs.

If an individual has no family they are accommodated in Social Service night shelters and are not be entitled to any financial assistance.

The Police

Public Order legislation officially bans rough sleeping and street population activities in public places. Police may take a harsh approach to rough sleepers. They may be more sympathetic to older homeless people and those who have lost their home and be willing to give out information about charities or day centres.
