



Routes Home Resolution fund

Purpose

There are a number of long term non-EEA rough sleepers in London with no recourse to public funds who are potentially entitled to leave to remain. In some cases the key barrier to them obtaining leave to remain is a lack of funding to support applications to the Home Office. The GLA has therefore set aside a small pot of funding, managed and administered by the Routes Home Service, for the purpose of facilitating applications for leave from long term non-EEA national rough sleepers with no recourse to public funds.

Criteria:

- Applications to the fund are open to GLA and borough-commissioned outreach services, No Second Night Out and Routes Home.
- The client must have a history of rough sleeping and their immigration status must be the key issue in preventing them from exiting rough sleeping - to be demonstrated in the application.
- The client must have a credible likelihood of leave being granted - to be demonstrated in the application.
- The client must have a good chance of exiting rough sleeping, should leave to remain be granted - to be demonstrated in the application.
- The organisation applying to the fund must be able to demonstrate their efforts to help the rough sleeper through CHAIN entries.
- The organisation applying to the fund must have agreement for equal match funding from a local authority or other body - to be demonstrated in the application. Exception from this requirement may be agreed by the GLA and the Routes Home service in exceptional circumstances.
- Following a successful application, the organisation receiving the funding must feed back on progress three months after the funding is granted (and, should the case not be resolved at that point, each three months thereafter).
